## Please comply with the following Campsite Rules.

- ★ All Camps and Nights Away experience or events must be run in accordance with the current Policy, Organisation and Rules of the Scout Association.
- ★ Entrance to the site is from a private gateway from Hocombe Road. This also serves the Private estate and must be kept locked at all times.
- ★ All vehicles must be parked in the car park area along the site entrance road. Vehicles may only be brought onto the site itself for unloading / loading of equipment.
- ★ The site is within the private Cranbury Park Estate. The Lake, Woodland and fields around the site are **out of bounds** to all site users. Use may be made of the public footpath along the northern side of the site.
- ★ The Wardens permission is required for all fires, whether in the main Camp Fire or on altar fires provided. NO FIRE is to be lit on the ground, except within the main campfire area.
- ★ No turfing, pits or fire holes to be dug, consequently only above ground wet pits may be used. Altar fires may be used for cooking.
- ★ No animals or birds of prey of any description are allowed on the site.
- ★ No Caravans or camper vans are allowed on site.
- ★ Please ensure that when you leave the site, it is left as you would expect to have found it on arrival.
- ★ The toilets drain into a septic tank and therefore nothing other than normal toilet waste or toilet tissue is flushed away.
- ★ The toilets must be kept and left clean and tidy.
- ★ All rubbish must be removed from the site when you leave. Long term campers may consult the warden concerning arrangements for rubbish disposal.
- ★ The site will be inspected before your departure and any damage must be paid for.
